From Park City you will take Valley Drive to Kearns Blvd. Turn right on Kearns Blvd. and proceed east. Stay on this road passing under the freeway (US 40) and all the way to the town of Kamas Utah. At the light turn left onto highway 150. Go north on highway 150 to Oakley, UT. As you go through Oakley you will see the old Diner on the right as you go up the hill. Stop and have a shake, it is a real treat! This is a fun one to two hour drive and one our club takes frequently.



Midway Utah Drive

Directions:

At the round-a-bout from Deer Valley to Park City take 224 (Marsac Ave.) south. When you reach the round-a-bout at the Montage Lodge stay on 224 toward Guardsman Pass, shortly you will come to a junction, turn left onto Guardsman Pass Road toward the town of Midway. When you come to a "Y" junction of Pine Canyon Rd. and Warm Springs Rd. (the golf course will be on your right) take the Warm Spring Rd. turn left on the Homestead Road. This road will take you into the town of Midway. There are several cafes and restaurants in Midway where you can stop for lunch. Just reverse the drive to get back to Park City or go east from Midway to the town of Heber and then north on Main Street all the way to the Park City exit off the Freeway (US-40).



Emigration Canyon Drive

Description;

Take the Park Avenue (U-224) north from Park City to Kimball Junction and then west on I-80 over Parley's Summit and exit I-80 at exit 13 (East Canyon). Turn right after the stop. Just two miles up U-65 you will see the turn off to Emigration Canyon on your right. Go up over the pass and down the canyon. Before you exit the canyon you will see Ruth's Diner on your left. This is a GREAT place for lunch. Just reverse the drive and you will back in Park City.



Sundance

Self-Guided Drive

Directions;

At the round-a-bout from Deer Valley to Park City take 224 (Marsac Ave.) south. When you reach the round-a-bout at the Montage Lodge stay on 224 toward Guardsman Pass, shortly you will come to a junction, turn left onto Guardsman Pass Road toward the town of Midway. When you come to a "Y" junction of Pine Canyon Rd. and Warm Springs Rd. (the golf course will be on your right) take the Warm Spring Rd. turn left on the Homestead Road. This road will take you into the town of Midway. Stay on this road until you come to N 400 W Street and then turn right. In a couple of blocks you will come to Main Street. Turn left and go east 4 blocks to Center Street, turn right toward Charleston. When you reach Charleston you will come to Highway 189, turn right. You will drive past Deer Creek Res. and on down Provo Canyon. Shortly you will see a right turn to Sundance. This is the home of Robert Redford. To get back to Park City just reverse the course to Midway or stay on the US-189 to Heber City. Don't get off the main road through Heber and it will take you up the freeway (US-40) to the Park City exit.



Brighton/Solitude Drive

Directions;

At the round-a-bout from Deer Valley to Park City take 224 (Marsac Ave.) south. When you reach the second round-a-bout at the Montage Lodge stay on 224 toward Guardsman Pass, shortly you will come to a junction. Stay to the right and keep going west up Guardsman Pass Road. Near the top the road becomes a little bumpy but is OK, just go slow and be careful. You are now heading west over Guardsman Pass. Stay on this road all the way to Big Cottonwood Canyon Road. At this point you turn left and drive through Brighton Ski resort. It is one-way traffic and will bring you right back to the main canyon road. It is a very short ride and worth the time. Then drive down the canyon just a few miles and you will come to Solitude Ski Resort. This is a large Bavarian Village and a lot of fun to walk through. If you are hungry go down the canyon a couple of more miles and you will see the Silver Fork Lodge on your left. Great food on the deck! To get back to Park City go back up the canyon until you see the Guardsman Pass Road on your left. Be careful going over the pass and in a couple of miles watch out for the Park City turnoff on the left. Have fun and enjoy the ride!
