

## FFNE2 Trip Itinerary

### Day 1, Monday, Sept. 16

Travel to Manchester NH.  
Check in to the Best Western Plus on South Willow Street.  
Across the parking lot is the Backyard Brewery serving food and spirits.  
Make sure you have a full tank of gas.  
Directions to the nearest gas station: Turn Right on to South Willow Street. At the flashing yellow light turn left on to Sheffield Rd.. Follow to the end of the street. Gas station is on the Left.

### Day 2, Tuesday, Sept. 17

Day trip along the Maine coast. We will travel to our farthest point, the Portland Head Light in Cape Elizabeth, Maine. This requires that we proceed through 2 toll booths. If you do not have an EZ-pass, the tolls are \$.75 and \$3.00. We will not stop to wait for everyone but will go slow until everyone catches up. Leaving the park, we will lunch at The Good Table Restaurant in Cape Elizabeth. Following lunch, we will travel US1 along the Maine coast. Dinner will be at Warrens Seafood Restaurant in Kittery Maine. Following dinner we will continue along the NH coast to Hampton Beach and then return to the hotel.

### Day 3, Wednesday, Sept. 18

Check out of the Best Western Plus.  
Ride South to the North Shore of Boston. Our first stop will be Salem, MA. and then we will travel to Essex for lunch at Woodman's. Following lunch, we will drive through Gloucester and Rockport.  
From Rockport, we will travel to Westford to check in to the Westford Regency Hotel.

However, you need to remember that the water taxi service ends at 6:00pm, so you need to be back at the pier to catch that last boat by 5:30pm.

Drive back to Manchester and check into the Best Western Plus in Manchester, NH.

#### Day 8, Monday, Sept 23

We will be traveling to Vermont. We will regroup in Nashua and will have an early lunch in Jaffrey. Our first stop in VT will be Manchester, VT. From there we will travel to South Royalton to the birth place of Joseph Smith. After leaving South Royalton, we will travel back to Manchester, NH. Our dinner stop will be in Henniker.

#### Day 9, Tuesday, Sept 24

We will travel to S. Weymouth, MA to meet up with Bill and Marlene Walker. They will lead the group on a ride to Plymouth, MA on Cape Cod. Those of you who went on the Viking River Cruise have met the Walkers.

#### Day 10, Wednesday, Sept 25

This will be a trip through some of Northern New Hampshire. We will have two tolls on this ride which is \$1.00 each going North and then South.
