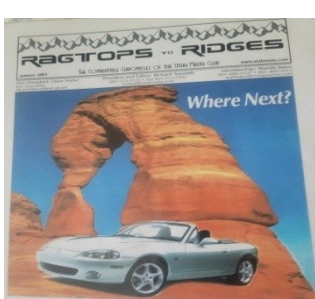
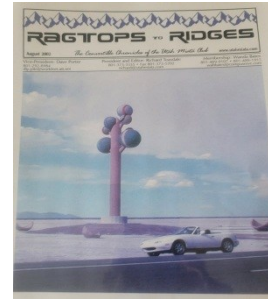
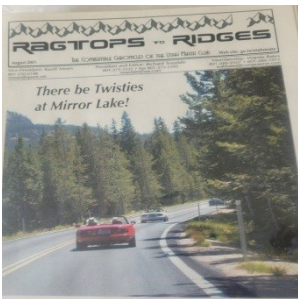
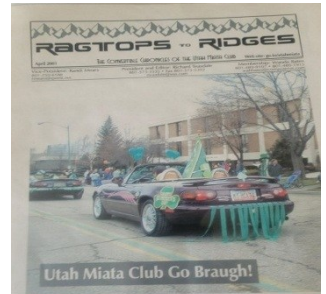
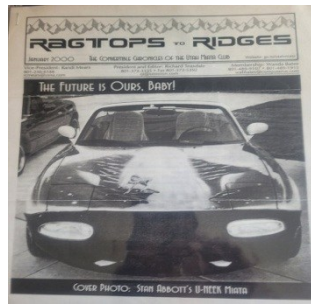
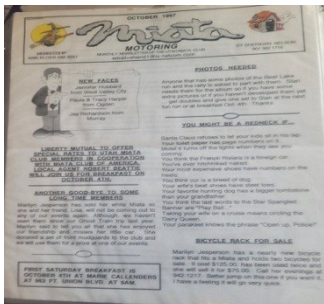
Newsworthy Items from UMC Members



Utah Miata Club Newsletters from the Past by Mike Bailey

The Utah Miata Club has been printing and sending monthly newsletters to its members since the beginning months that the club started. In those years the newsletter was mailed which was before we used email. In the early 1990's the newsletter was called **"Miata Motoring."** It had a couple of graphics at the top which related to the month it was published. (ie: October has some Halloween graphics, December Christmas art). In the late 90's the name of the monthly Newsletter was titled **"Ragtops to Ridges"** an appropriate name and title because we are located in the Rocky Mountains and we did lots of drives in the mountains! The graphics were a hand-drawn image of mountain peaks above the newsletter's name.

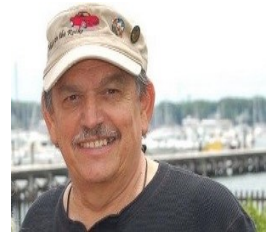
In the 1990's the newsletter usually had a large photo featured on page one from one of our drives or events. The club **'slogan'** for the newsletter was **"The Convertible Chronicles of the Utah Miata Club"** and was under the **'Ragtops to Ridges'** name which is still the same today! In the early to mid 2000's the masthead changed a little and featured the Official Logo on it. The current masthead now contains a photo of a row of **Utah Miata Club Miata's** that was taken at the Summer Picnic in 2002 at a park in Bountiful and now features the **'Mountains'** club logo. We had a large 8' tall flag made in the mid 2000's which we display at our Summer Picnic & Elections and Planning meeting and also use it during parades and other festivities. We also have a large Utah Miata Club Banner which we have used at many events through the years. It must be in my or another club member's garage somewhere! Another newsworthy note is that we have the club's **"Red Lobster" Award** that we've used at annual Road Rally's in the past for a "last place award" usually, however we started using it a couple years ago starting with the "Ghosts & Legends" event as a **"First Place"** trophy! Today's Red Lobster has more decorations than the one shown below.

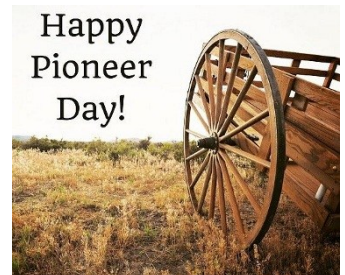

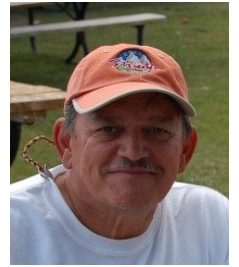

Utah License Plate Options for 2026 by Mike Bailey

There is a brand new Utah license plate that just came out which I got for my Miata. To celebrate America's 250th Anniversary, Utah (as well as several other states have come out with a 250th Anniversary license plate. There is a short window for ordering them if you want one for one of your vehicles. Here are some details on the new plate from Utah's Dept. of Motor Vehicles:



Utah's "America 250" license plate commemorated the United States' 250th Anniversary and will be available from June 1, 2026 through July 31, 2027.

The America 250 plate features a **deep blue background** with the **1776 American flag draped along the left side**, symbolizing the nation's founding. The design also includes **13 stars encircling "1776"** to honor the original 13 colonies, while a subtle pattern of Utah's beehive logo appears on the right side, maintaining a clean and recognizable look consistent with Utah's design standards Utah.gov+2. This plate is part of Utah's standard-issue options, alongside the Delicate Arch, Life Elevated skier, and In God We Trust. **This is a special order plate!** It can also be personalized but with only 6 letters or numbers but for an additional cost. Mine were \$95.00 and you can get either one or two plates. You will have to wait and see what mine says. I wanted another phrase with Mazda's Zoom Zoom motto like I had on my Blazing Yellow back in the day, however the names were taken.
