class. The parking lot featured a tiny handful of American muscle cars: my BFF's Pontiac GTO, a Chevrolet El Camino with the big block 454, a bright green Plymouth Superbird with the (silly) high-wing rear spoiler and the 426 Hemi, and a '68 Corvette with the 427 and a T-Top. There were probably a few others. But the everyday cars were like my (mother's) '59 Ford Fairlane—which I drove one day each week during my senior year. The newer cars were similar to my neighbor's '71 Pinto. In the main there were sedans and station wagons.

In high school (Skyline '72), for me, British roadsters were tops. The school was middle

In all that, the cars that caught my heart were British Roadsters: a good friend's 1960 Triumph TR3 and another friend's 1962 Austin Healey. In fact, I really wanted a Triumph TR6, though I would have "settled" for a TR250. It turns out I didn't want either enough to get serious about buying. Pre-owned models could be had for around \$2,000.

I was working 10 – 15 hours a week, after school, and making \$1.25 / hour. Do the math. If I had saved every penny, it would have taken more than 3 years. They might as well have cost a million.

Fast forward to 2016. Our four children are in various stages of adulthood, and we have just returned to the USA (Florida) after living several years in Chile. 'You know what? I'm going to finally get me that TR6.' It didn't take much research to determine that a person who buys a 40+ year-old TR6 is a person who likes working on cars. Not me. Was there a roadster that would be fun to drive, reliable, and within my budget? A 2008 Miata became my daily driver in Florida's year-round top-down weather. I sold it in

2021 (a year after joining the UMC) and bought a 2015 Miata PRHT. Loved it. This year we gave ourselves a retirement gift, by upgrading to a 2022 Miata Grand Touring soft-top (see elsewhere in this issue). We have so much fun getting together with the club and driving our cars. I hope you all feel the same!






